Project Description: CMTHS students will engage in art-based work to examine their personal belief systems and how their beliefs relate to their chosen career path. Students will work with a teaching artist from the Fabric Workshop & Museum to create either a mixed-media teaching philosophy statement or artist statement.

Essential Questions

- (ECE & TA) Who am I as a future educator? What does it mean to teach?
- (Vis Comm & V/S Production) Who am I as an artist? What does it mean to be an artist?

Project Objectives

- Using the arts to express their ideas, students will examine their own identities in order to articulate a vision for their future professional lives.
- Students will write a one-page teaching philosophy or artist statement that they will creatively incorporate into their final mixed-media project.

Project Highlights

- 2 Field Trips to Philadelphia to The Fabric Workshop & Museum (December & April)
- Bi-Monthly arts workshops at CMTHS where you will engage in a variety of printing techniques, print your own designs, and create a mixed-media teaching or artist statement.
- Bi-Monthly writing workshops on selected topics; these workshops will help you uncover your own beliefs about the world and help you think through, and in some cases, rethink your beliefs.
- Silk-screen print a large-scale collaborative fabric at FWM.
